Belt and Road Initiative (BRI) – Redefining Global Trade

BRI remains one of China's most ambitious global projects to connect regions and continents with each other through an intricate trade network involving road, rail and sea routes. Involving 152 countries spanning across Asia and Central and Eastern Europe, an estimated USD4 trillion are set to be invested in infrastructure corridors of 65 countries representing 75% of the world's population, 55% of its GNP and 75% of its energy reserves. This is bound to drastically reshape global trade within the Eurasian region. But concerns over 'debt trap' continue to hamper efforts. Are these concerns justified? What is the actual mechanism of infrastructure investments? What are the business opportunities available under BRI? Where is BRI going from here?

ASEAN Panel – Strengthening the Long-term Partnership between China and ASEAN

Two-way trade between China and ASEAN grew by 14.1 percent to a record USD587.87 billion in 2018, compared to 2017. China has been ASEAN's top trading partner for 10 consecutive years, while ASEAN has been China's third largest trading partner, after the European Union and the United States, for eight years in a row. The gap between China-ASEAN trade volumes and China-US trade volumes narrowed significantly by about 33 percent from USD68.9 billion in 2017 to USD457 billion in 2018. This shows huge potential for the partnership to grow further especially in the midst of the protectionist mood in the West. What could be done to step-up trade between China and ASEAN? What are the institutions and policies to focus on? What are the promising business opportunities to look out for in the next decade?







ROLE PLAYERS' PROFILE



THE HON. C.Y. LEUNG

The Hon. C.Y. Leung is the Vice Chairman of the China People's Political Consultative Conference (CPPCC) and the former Chief Executive of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region.

The Hon. C.Y. Leung graduated from King's College, Hong Kong Polytechnic and Bristol Polytechnic. He has been awarded Honorary Doctorate degrees by four universities in the United Kingdom, Hong Kong and Shandong.

He was Chairman of the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors Hong Kong, President of the Institute of Surveyors in Hong Kong and Asia Pacific Chairman of DTZ. Since late 1970s, The Hon. C.Y. Leung had participated in the land and housing reforms in the Mainland. After the constitution was amended in 1988, he assisted Mainland cities in land leasing matters on a voluntary basis. Between 1984 and 1997, The Hon. C.Y. Leung was involved in the preparatory work for the establishment on the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region. Between 1997 and 2011, he was a member of the Executive Council of Hong Kong and was the Convenor of the non-official members between 1999 and 2011.



THE HON. DATO' SERI ANWAR IBRAHIM

The Hon. Dato' Seri Anwar Ibrahim is internationally known as a Muslim democrat and a reformist. Hailed as the Father of Reformasi in Malaysia and abroad because of his struggle against injustice and corruption. A progressive leader who are keen in putting forth the agenda of everyday, ordinary Malaysian regardless of race, colour and creed. Dato' Seri Anwar Ibrahim was a political prisoner, twice imprisoned under politically-motivated charges, the first on in 1998 until 2004 and the second stint lasted from 2015 to 2018. Notwithstanding difficulties faced by him, Anwar Ibrahim still aspire to champion the cause of the people to a new, better Malaysia.

The Hon. Dato' Seri Anwar served as the Deputy Prime Minister of Malaysia from 1993 to 1998 and Finance Minister from 1991 to 1998 when he was a member of UMNO, the major party in the ruling Barisan Nasional coalition. He is currently the President of People's Justice Party and leader of the Pakatan Harapan coalition.

The Hon. Dato' Seri Anwar undertook his secondary education at the Malay College Kuala Kangsar and received his degree in Malay Studies from the University of Malaya.

He is married to YAB Dato' Seri Dr Wan Azizah Wan Ismail, the current Deputy Prime Minister of Malaysia and they have four daughters and a son. His eldest daughter, Nurul Izzah Anwar, is also a member of Parliament for Permatang Pauh.



DATO' MUZAFFAR HISHAM

Dato' Muzaffar Hisham is the Group CEO, Global Banking of Malayan Banking Berhad. He leads Group Global Banking's business growth and regionalisation strategies for service including corporate and transaction banking, investment banking, treasury, asset management and client coverage.

Dato' Muzaffar has collectively 23 years of experience in the banking and financial services.





Bamba Oliano is the National Director of Private Sector Promotion and Country Competitiveness, Ministry of Investments and Private-Public Partnerships, Republic of Guinea. He is responsible for working on the country's performance indicators to promote its attractiveness to potential investors. To this end, he sets up promotion mechanisms for the various sectors of activity to encourage the creation of businesses and to promote the growth of existing ones. The promotion of young and female entrepreneurship is also at the heart of its program.

Whilst serving in ICAC, in 1986, he led a joint ICAC/Police Task Force with 30 officers to investigate the collapse of the third largest local bank in Hong Kong. He was subsequently awarded a Governor Commendation for his leadership and professional ability in this case. Since his retirement in 2002, he has been invited to 26 countries and 60 cities in China to provide professional anti-corruption consultancy, lectures, and to conduct anti-corruption seminars and workshops.
