

OVERVIEW

The Covid-19 pandemic has significantly shifted geopolitics, global health and political elections around the world. The current global economic uncertainties have pushed countries to identify new market opportunities and rise above the storm. Despite facing uncertainties due to the pandemic, the situation has brought about new opportunities for diversification to countries in the region. Economic policies, markets and businesses are transforming at an unprecedented time. Investor confidence is challenged in every way. Technological advances accelerate and governments continue to adapt to the changing pandemic situation.



President Xi Jinping in his speech at the recent World Economic Forum pushed for a global cooperation as the best way to defeat the pandemic and other global crisis. A new economic model is urgently needed. A model where nations are interconnected and trade flourishes. The Silk Road of centuries past has ushered in a period of relative peace between nations. Today, the Belt and Road Initiative (BRI) seeks to emulate that period of peace, where nations are interconnected by rail, road and maritime routes with internet and technology at the forefront. Can BRI bring ASEAN to greater heights? Will Asia be the center stage for a new economic model? Is this the time for Pax Asiana?



China's economy roared back to pre-pandemic growth rates in the fourth quarter as its industrial engines fired up to meet surging demand for exports, pushing the full-year expansion beyond estimates and propelling its global advance. With economic recovery, success in controlling the pandemic, vaccine availability and policy normalisation; China's private sector is expected to resume its role as the leading growth driver, taking GDP from a drag of 0.5%pts in 2020 to a lift of 6.6%pts in 2021.



11th WCEF



After a very successful 11th WCEF in Hangzhou on 11 to 12 December 2019, where more than 1000 delegates from 29 countries gathered to explore business and investment opportunities between China and the Asian region, the 12th WCEF 2020 will be held back in Kuala Lumpur. The decision to move back to Kuala Lumpur this year is partly due to Covid-19 pandemic, where strict restriction for foreign travelers into China is in placed at the moment. Hence, the forum this year will be held in hybrid mode for the first time.



The 12th WCEF will continue to remain significant, relevant, and current on discussion related to trade, investment, health, social and cultural development. We will continue to look at China and the Chinese diaspora link to the world by engaging on business, political, academic, and other leaders of society in shaping global, regional, and industry agendas.



11th WCEF



Malaysia, the venue for this year, is a melting pot of cultures as the cities are incredibly diverse and rich in cultural heritage. Malaysia has forged its global reputation as a high-income, multicultural nation with strong GDP despite the relatively small population. Malaysia is also ranked high on the ease of business, as well as on connectivity. This is due to its strategic geographical location and connectivity which served as the gateway to ASEAN, and the rest of the world. In the Muslim world, Malaysia has also established itself as a halal hub for the 1.9 billion global Muslim population command US 2.3 trillion in spending.

As digital media enters our everyday lives, areas such as data privacy and fake news need to be addressed. Many media organisations and social media tech companies have taken the initiative to create platforms for fact-checking, however, long term solutions must focus on providing free media, law enforcement, and media literacy.

The global impact of climate change, pollutions and for-profit development are redefining the long-term partnership between China and ASEAN. Companies must look beyond maximizing profits and invest for the benefits of the people and the environment.

Besides that, both the government and corporations need to address global waste issues to reduce pollutants from entering the ocean and land. Among the ways to address are through innovative technology and comprehensive policy, Meanwhile, governments play a vital role in reducing of the use of fossil fuels and in promoting renewable energy in its economy.






By 2035, the 5G network is estimated to have a value chain of 2.5 trillion. The 5G network is the preferred choice in the agriculture industry due to its low latency and fast transmission. Some farmers are adopting the IoT devices to monitor the fertiliser and water level in farms, and even use drones for surveillance.

With the advance of 5G in the health care sector, patients can see a cost reduction of up to USD700 billion as health care services can be provided remotely. Patients can consult doctors online, while doctors can perform surgeries and conduct conferences remotely.

Most of today's IoT devices centred on sensor technology used in a variety of spaces and devices. Cloud is also an important platform for big data, especially for big and small companies as it is cheaper, though some are concerned that it may lead to information leak.


